

Koninginnedag or Queen's Day

Koninginnedag or Queen's Day is a national holiday in the Netherlands on April 30, one day prior to the skin cancer course.

Queen's Day celebrates the birthday of the Queen of the Netherlands and is known for its "freemarket" all over the country, where everybody is allowed to sell things in the streets. Other activities during Queen's Day are children's games, individual musical performances, and music concerts. The largest celebration of Queen's Day is in Amsterdam and Utrecht. The night before Queen's Day, April 29, is also celebrated and called Queen's Night. During the celebrations as reference to the colours of the House of Orange-Nassau, people dress in the colour orange, which is sometimes called "orange craze".

Approximately 85% of all skin cancer originates in the head and neck region and incidence is rapidly increasing. Most skin cancer is diagnosed and treated by family practitioners and dermatologists. In case of more complex skin cancer also other medical specialists participate in a multidisciplinary approach.

This symposium deals with the process of diagnosis and treatment of primary skin cancer and its regional metastases. Also local flap physiology and planning is discussed as well as proper reconstructive flap selection and techniques for more complex skin cancer defects.

The symposium concerns a one day intensive course for residents and specialists working in the field of dermatology, otolaryngology, maxillofacial surgery, plastic surgery, and general surgery.
