

International Guest Speakers

Dr. Abdülkadir Göksel is board certified by the European Board of Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery. He is an international member of American Academy of the Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery, European Academy of Facial Plastic Surgery, European Rhinoplasty Society, Turkish Facial Plastic Surgery Foundation.

Dr. Göksel was an International Invited Speaker in many International Congresses in Europe, Russia, Asia, Turkey. In 2001 he founded Rino Istanbul Rhinoplasty Center in Istanbul. He mainly focused on rhinoplasty in the last 15 years. Although he is in private practice, Dr. Göksel is active in the teaching of rhinoplastic surgery at national and international levels. During the last nearly 10 years he personally trained young surgeons in the art and science of rhinoplasty surgery.

Since 2005 Dr. Göksel took part as a guest speaker and moderator in more than 40 professional events.

Dr. Göksel is a permanent chairman of the Istanbul Rhinoplasty Workshop.

Dr. Palhazi's specialty is clinical anatomy and plastic surgery. He has performed dissections regularly for years to gain an understanding of facial anatomy and surgery. He is currently the Chairman of the Clinical Anatomy Focus Group of the European Academy of Facial Plastic Surgery, founding member of the International Rhinoplasty Research Society.

His main field of interest is facial plastic surgery, especially rhinoplasty and nonsurgical aesthetic procedures. He published several research articles and book chapters from breast surgery to the salivary glands. He has published a landmark anatomical and surgical book on rhinoplasty, providing an authoritative and hugely detailed account of this fascinating subject. He recently published a second rhinoplasty book on preservation rhinoplasty, that developed from in-depth anatomical knowledge of the face.

He published a DVD atlas, called: Applied Anatomy of the Face for Filler and Botulinum Toxin Injection. Furthermore, he has written several book chapters on the topic of facial fillers and facial anatomy. He regularly lectures on rhinoplasty, facial anatomy internationally all over the world.

About the Course

The course is aimed at practising surgeons and registrars. Both Plastic and ENT surgeons are welcome. There are two days dedicated to both lectures and dissection with two groups dissecting. The lectures cover both basic concepts plus an extended program for experienced rhinoplasty surgeons.

Areas to be covered

1. Anatomy and anatomical variations relevant to rhinoplastic surgery. Including a "functional preservation" focus.
2. Instrumentation required in rhinoplasty
3. Preparation and pre-op planning
4. Facial aesthetics
5. Osteotomy techniques in rhinoplasty
7. Nasal tip and septal extension graft support surgery
8. Tensioning of nasal valve techniques along with traditional graft support
9. Endoscopic turbinoplasty and maintaining the nasal airway
10. Post-operative care and management

Faculty

George Marcellis is the immediate past President of the Australasian Academy of Facial Plastic Surgery and director of Bondi Junction Private Hospital. He is a US board exam certified facial plastic surgeon and has extensive experience in rhinoplasty.

Dr Sim Choroomi is a Sydney based facial plastic surgeon with American Board training based in Los Angeles with a research focus on Rhinoplastic techniques.

Dr Floreani is an Adelaide based surgeon and one of Australia's leading rhinoplasty surgeons. He continues to evolve current techniques and teaches regularly in North America.

Professor Richard Harvey is a dedicated Rhinologist and international speaker in disorders of the nose, sinus and nasal breathing. He has expertise in difficult and revision rhinoplasty and has published research in the field.

All members of the Faculty have wide experience in the management of cosmetic and functional nasal surgery including rhinoplasty techniques. They are actively involved in teaching and research.
